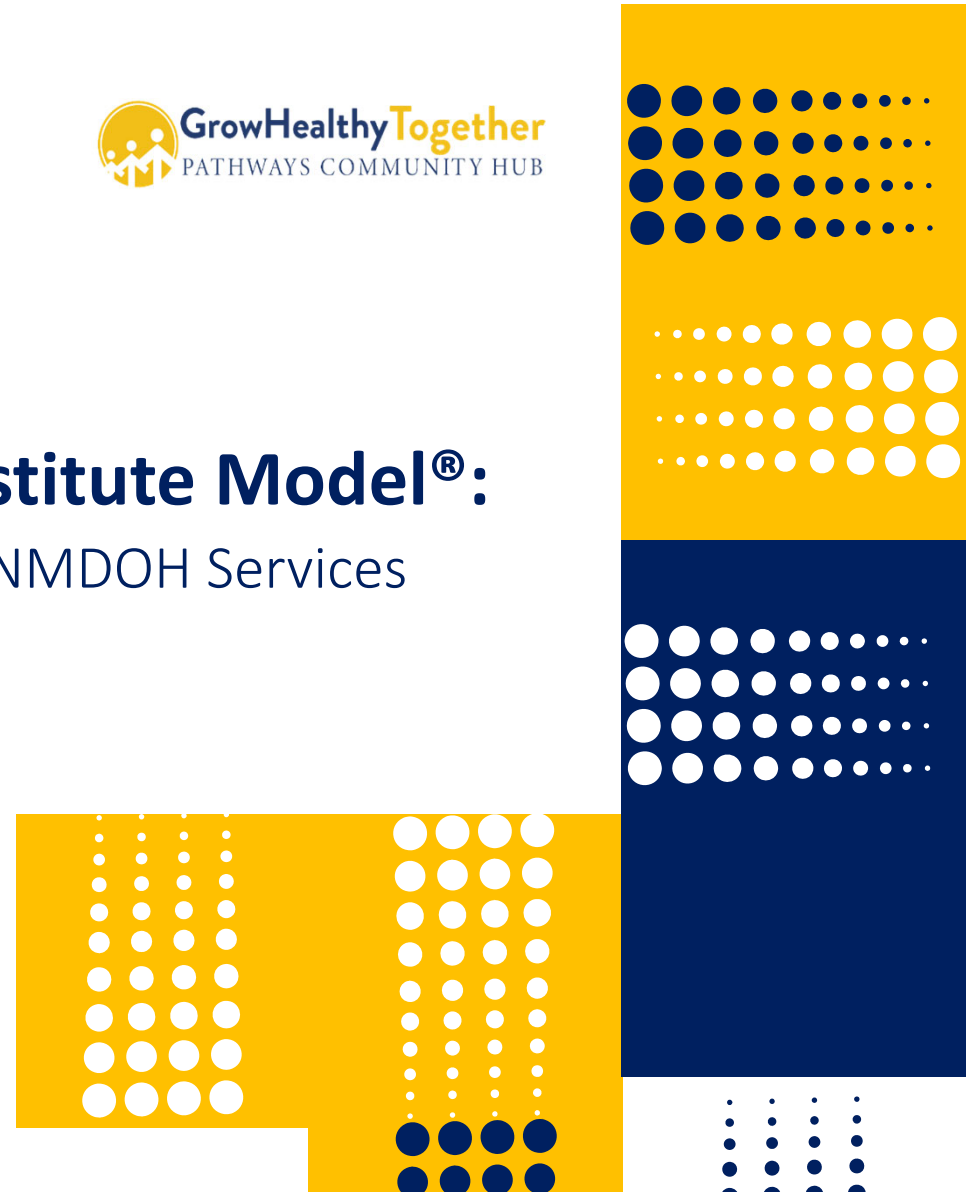

Current Literature on the HUB Model



↓ Poor birth outcomes

- ↓ Low birth weight^{1,2}
 - 60% reduction¹
- ↓ Preterm birth²

- Positive predictors of birth outcomes³:
 - Social Service Referral Pathway
 - Frequent Prenatal visits



↓ Neonatal Intensive Care Unit admissions⁴



↑ Cost savings by averting poor birth outcomes

↑ > \$5 return for every \$1 invested in Pathways HUB model¹

↑ 236% ROI for every dollar invested in HUB intervention⁴

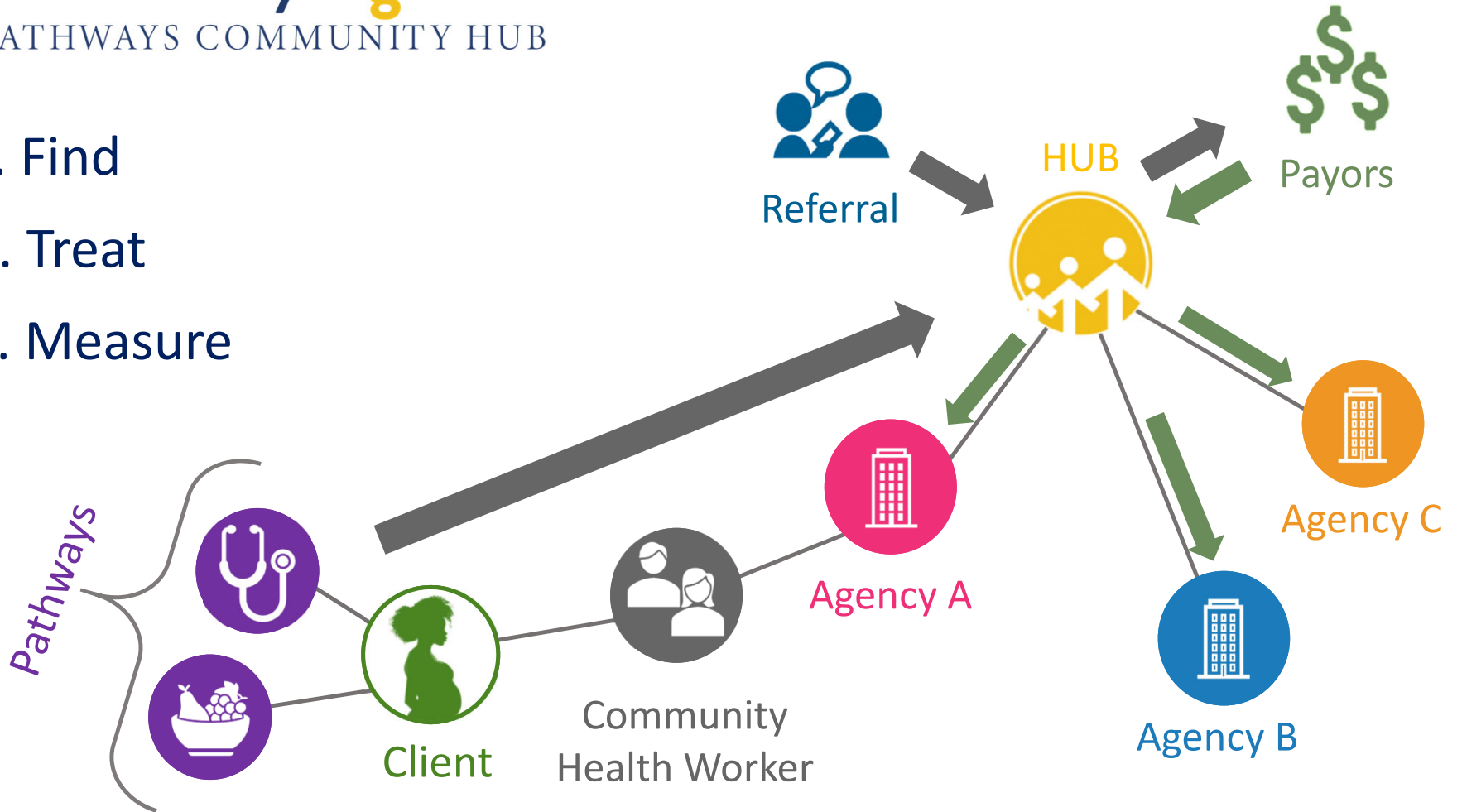

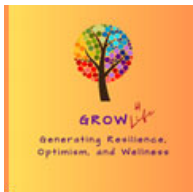

 - Grants



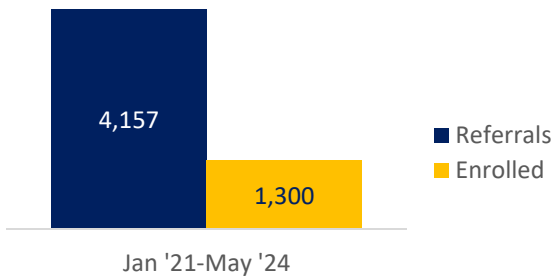
Payment Structure: Contract

- Identify population of interest for HUB services
- Negotiate OBU Rate dollar amount for service activity
 - Engagement fee
 - Standard visit forms
 - 21 Pathways
 - Additional Tools (optional)
- Develop contract, business associate agreement, business service agreement, statement of work, etc.

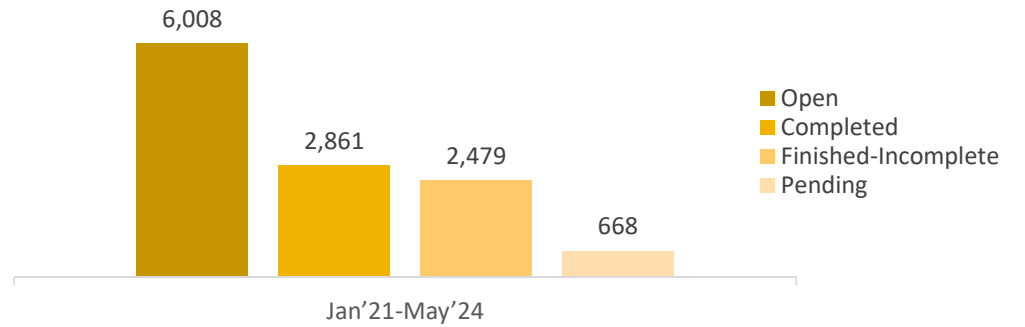

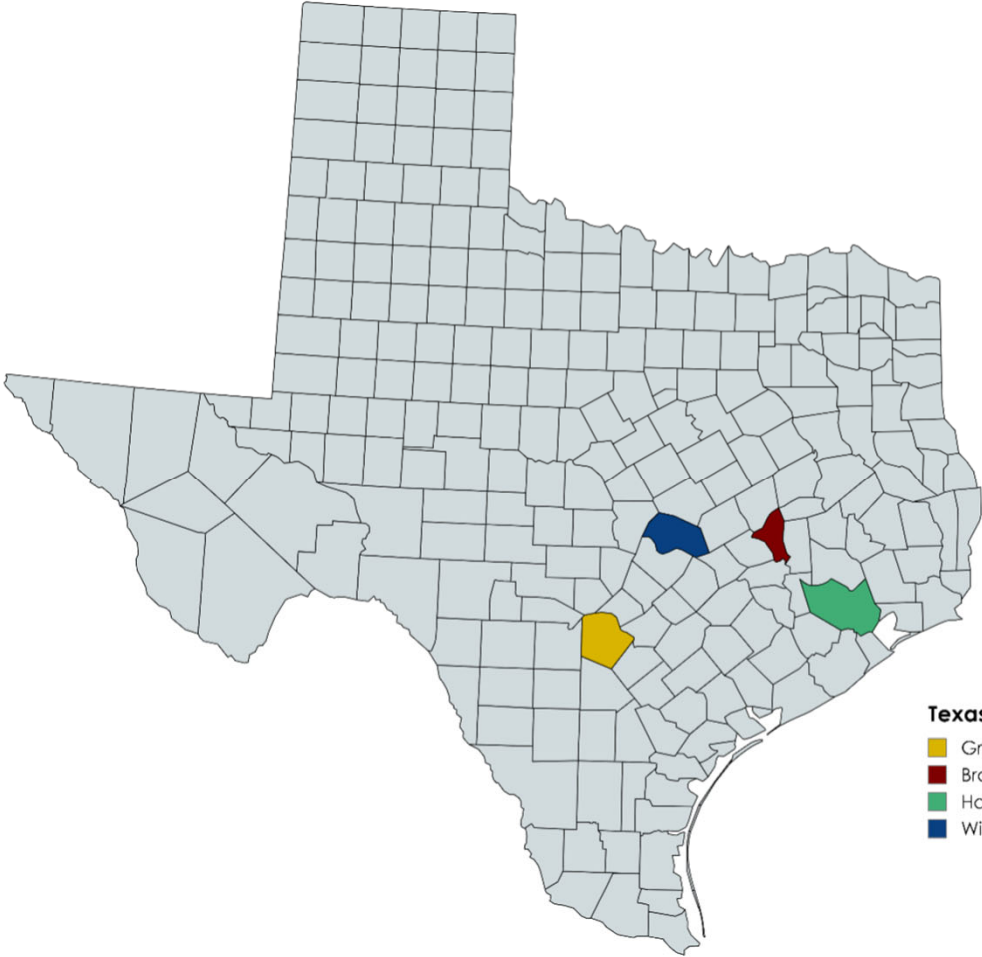
